Schedule of Events:

THURSDAY, SEPTEMBER 24 – PRACTICE ROUND

There are no assigned tee times for the practice round. We suggest that you play before 10:00 a.m. if you plan to play all 18 holes. The Molsen Coors Par 3 Contest taking place for all Member-Guest participants will begin at 2:30 p.m. with a shotgun start on the back nine. Each hole will have its own Closest to the Pin (CTP) contest. All CTP winners and the winning scramble team will compete in a final CTP contest from near #1 tee to #18 green. There will be a Kick-Off Party, presented by our sponsors, for players starting at 7:00 p.m. on the Golf Shop patio (dress accordingly – weather expected to drop into the 60s). The party is a stag party for tournament participants only. We will also have a Calcutta auction of the teams paid out via the flight results and the Horserace. The Calcutta will begin at approximately 7:30 p.m.

FRIDAY, SEPTEMBER 25 – THREE NINE-HOLE MATCHES

The tournament will begin promptly at 7:45 a.m. (exact hole assignments are listed on the following pages) and you will play three consecutive nine-hole matches, against the other teams in your flight. There will be breakfast available at 7:00 a.m. as well as a boxed lunch available during your second round. The Member-Guest Dinner following play will begin at 7:00 p.m. The dress code is business casual (please no shorts, caps or open-toed shoes) during the dinner.

Shotgun starts: 7:45 a.m. / 10:45 a.m. / 1:45 p.m.

- * After each nine-hole match, attest to the accuracy of the digital scoring.
- * Begin play as soon as both teams have arrived at the starting hole.

SATURDAY, SEPTEMBER 26 – TWO NINE-HOLE MATCHES

Play resumes at 7:45 a.m. where the two remaining matches will be played consecutively against the two teams remaining in your flight. There will be breakfast available at 7:00 a.m. as well as lunch after your final round. The flight winners and two (2) Wildcard Winners will participate in a Horserace Playoff to determine the overall Member~Guest Champions at approximately 2:15 p.m. Once Champions have been established, we will have the awards ceremony on #18 green. We ask that ALL Flight Winners and Horserace participants attend to receive their awards.

Shotgun starts: 7:45 a.m. / 10:45 a.m.

Format:

Round Robin Four-Ball (Low Net Ball of Partners)

Each team will play a nine-hole match against each of the other teams in their flight. A schedule of the pairings is included. Matches will start on the assigned hole and continue around the nine that you began play on.

Flighting
And Seeds:

Teams were ranked one (1) through forty-eight (48) by adding together the teammates indexes. Individual handicaps will be adjusted to 80% after flighting. Flights were assembled by dividing the field in groups of six based on their seeds. Lowest Member's handicap index was used to break flight ties.

Scoring:

A total of TEN points are available in each match.

Points will be awarded to each team according to the following formula.

Each hole won 1 point
Each hole halved ½ point
Each match won 1 point
Each match halved ½ point

Handicaps:

In each match, the handicaps of all players shall be reduced by the handicap of the low player in the group, who shall then play at zero. The shots fall as the scorecard plays.

Ties:

In the event of a two-way tie for first place in a flight, the winning team will be decided on the basis of the head-to-head match between the two teams. If the head-to-head match resulted in a tie, the teams shall chip off to decide the winner. If there are two or more teams tied for wild card spot(s), those teams shall chip off to decide the winner(s). The tie-breaker chip offs will be at the Putting Green.

Rules:

U.S.G.A. Rules are in effect except where amended by Local Rules.

- All flights will play from the Gold tee markers, except for:
 - o Participants age 60+ may play from the Blue tee markers.
 - o Participants age 70+ may play from the White tee markers.
- The 14-club limit is in effect.
- Rocks surrounding 18 green are obstructions. Stance and swing relief may be taken no closer to the hole.
- Integral parts of the course: Includes (a) Retaining wall on #8.
- Temporary Immovable Obstructions: Greenside fans, starting, scoring and concession tents are deemed to be TIO's (temporary immovable obstructions).
- Out of Bounds local rule is in place. Drop two club lengths into the nearest part of the fairway from where your ball crossed the O.B. Penalty will be two shots. You also still have the option of stroke and distance with a 1 shot penalty.
- Distance-measuring devices. In this competition, a player may obtain distance information by using a device that measures distance only. If, during a stipulated round, a player uses a distance-measuring device that is designed to gauge or measure other conditions that might affect his play (e.g., gradient, wind speed, temperature, etc.), the player is in breach of Rule 14-3.

Inclement Weather:

In the case of suspended play, players shall mark the position of their golf ball and discontinue play.



Pace of Play:

Please keep in mind the following guidelines for faster play: be ready to hit when it is your turn, pick up if you are out of the hole and play fast.

Determining the Member~Guest Champions

Wildcards:

The 2 Wildcard spots for the Horserace:

- The first qualifier will be determined by the highest 2nd place score total from the Nicklaus, Hogan, Palmer and Player flights.
- The second qualifier will be determined by the highest 2nd place score total from the Snead, Watson, Sarazen and Hagen flights.

Horserace:

The Horserace will determine the overall Member~Guest Champions. The ten (10) team field will be split into two (2) groups of five (5). The five (5) lowest team handicaps will begin play on #10, while the five (5) highest team handicaps will compete starting on #14. The format played will be four ball (low net ball of partners) using tournament handicaps. The holes that will be played are:

Hole #10	(9 th handicap hole)	2 teams eliminated
Hole #11	(7 th handicap hole)	1 team eliminated
Hole #14	(3 rd handicap hole)	2 teams eliminated
Hole #15	(13 th handicap hole)	1 team eliminated

The four remaining teams will meet on #16 tee, 1 team will be eliminated

The three remaining teams will play #17, 1 team will be eliminated

The final two teams will play for the championship on #18, if there is a tie, #18 will be replayed until a winner is determined.

10 TEAM HORSERACE

CONDITIONS AND RULES OF PLAY

- 1. The Horserace will determine the overall Member~Guest Champions. The ten-team field will be split into two groups of five. The five lowest team handicaps will begin play on #10, while the five highest team handicaps will compete starting on #14. The format played will be four ball (low net ball of partners) using tournament handicaps.
- 2. The ball will be played as it lies.
- 3. Any ball 18" or closer to the hole will be a "gimme" as measured by a rules official. Practice during play and/or between holes is prohibited.
- 4. The Shadow Valley C.C. Rules of Play Card and USGA Rules will govern play.
- 5. The Holes played with the number of teams eliminated are:

Hole #10	(9 th handicap hole)	2 teams eliminated
Hole #11	(7 th handicap hole)	1 team eliminated
Hole #14	(3 rd handicap hole)	2 teams eliminated
Hole #15	(13th handicap hole)	1 team eliminated

The four remaining teams will meet on #16 tee, 1 team will be eliminated

The three remaining teams will play #17, 1 team will be eliminated

The final two teams will play for the championship on #18, if there is a tie, #18 will be replayed until a winner is determined

All ties prior to the final hole will be broken by a chip off to determine which team(s) move on. Only 1 person per team may hit the chip shot. Any players involved in the chip off may not face the hole until instructed to do so. Chips must be on the green to qualify.

The Payoff: 20% of the Calcutta will be paid in the shootout. The following percentages will be applied based on when a team is eliminated.

1st Place: 50% 2nd Place: 25% 3rd Place: 15% 4th Place: 10%
